Advice for institutions outside Turkey to help Turkish academics

(1) Faculty members need to take the initiative by approaching administrators (e.g., department chairs, deans, administrators in international studies) about the possibilities of hosting Turkish scholars in visiting positions. The explanation of the Turkish situation may help orient administrators to the urgency of the situation.

(2) A prospective host institution should contact either **Scholars at Risk** or the **Scholar Rescue Fund**.

(a) **Scholars at Risk**. Go to www.scholarsatrisk.org/turkey-response/ and click on the “Host a Scholar” icon at the bottom of the page (in the middle). The link features a list of scholars (no names given) from various countries seeking placement; scroll down for Turkey. As of this writing, only a handful of Turkish scholars are listed. Contact Scholars at Risk directly for additional information.

(b) **Scholar Rescue Fund** (www.scholarrescuefund.org/hosts) matches support for an at-risk scholar up to \$25,000 for a one-year appointment.
